## **PPD South-South Annual Population Award Nominations 2015**

### **1. Introduction**

Population challenges and population goals of several developing countries are similar. ICPD has identified these challenges and addressed them with the philosophy of collaborative effort of the Global South. The initial ten countries collectively decided to create a formal intergovernmental mechanism to capture the collaborative opportunity of the Global South. Therein lies the genesis of PPD. Currently, PPD has expanded to a global intergovernmental alliance of 26 countries representing more than 59% of the world population. The experiences of PPD have been shaped by a sharp sense of South to South solidarity fostered among the PPD member countries. The prime mandate of PPD is to promote South-South Cooperation (SSC) for Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR), and Population and Development under the ICPD PoA. PPD, a unique southern-led and southern-run alliance of 26 governments has already travelled 20 years with its own diverse experiences; PPD believes that now it is time to recognize and promote excellence in the advancement of ICPD PoA.

### **2. Rationale**

PPD is making efforts to accumulate all its experiences and achievements and parallelly is working to identify and recognize the efforts, wisdom, knowledge and sagacity of individuals, institutions and networks who have extended their cooperation towards the South-South Cooperation for Population, SRHR and development. It is in this context that the highest decision making authority of PPD, the Executive Committee has decided to announce the PPD South-South Population Award for work, initiatives, experience and efforts where south-south cooperation has been highlighted. Another purpose of the PPD South-South Population Award is to promote cost effective, innovative and cutting edge program and project initiatives, strategies, tools and productions that can be replicated in PPD member and other developing countries. These would be taken as best practices to advance the implementation of the ICPD PoA from 2014 within the SSC and social development frameworks beyond 2015.

### **3. Award categories**

The awards will recognize program and project initiatives, strategies, productions and tools that further PPD SSC key strategic approaches (reflected below) that have advanced the ICPD PoA agenda and implementation, provided solutions, and contributed to policy change, realization of increased awareness and commitments (political, financial and programming) towards universal access to SRHR, population stabilization and sustainable development at domestic (in PPD

member countries), regional and global levels. The awards will be given in the following categories:

1. Policy & Advocacy/ Population Diplomacy
2. Capacity building, leadership, skills development, transfer of technology, information, expertise
3. Partnerships/networks and Research/evidence uptake

#### **4. Award nominee eligibility criteria**

Only representatives from PPD member countries will be eligible for nomination.

The awards are open for:

- Individuals.
- Institutions (e.g. academic and research).

#### **5. Selection Criteria for PPD Population Award**

- A project or activities which have potential for promoting South-South Cooperation.
- Evidence based south-south activities that have resulted in policy/program replication and capacity building at the national level.
- Sharing good practices addressing policy, programmatic and operational issues in the field of population and reproductive health in PPD MCs.
- Opportunity for south-south partnership for commodity security in reproductive health in PPD MCs.

#### **6. Nomination procedure**

- All nominations should be submitted in writing.
- Each nominator can only submit one nomination.

#### **7. Nomination period**
