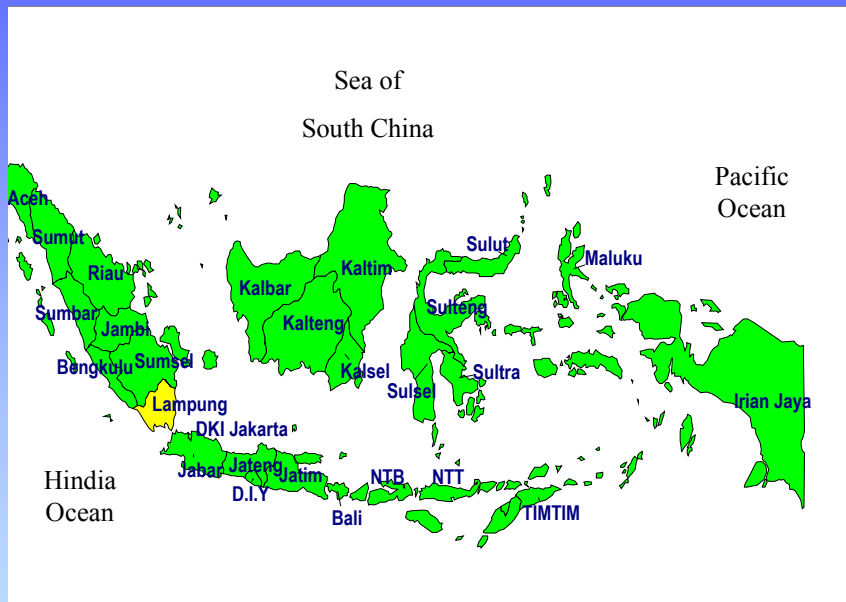

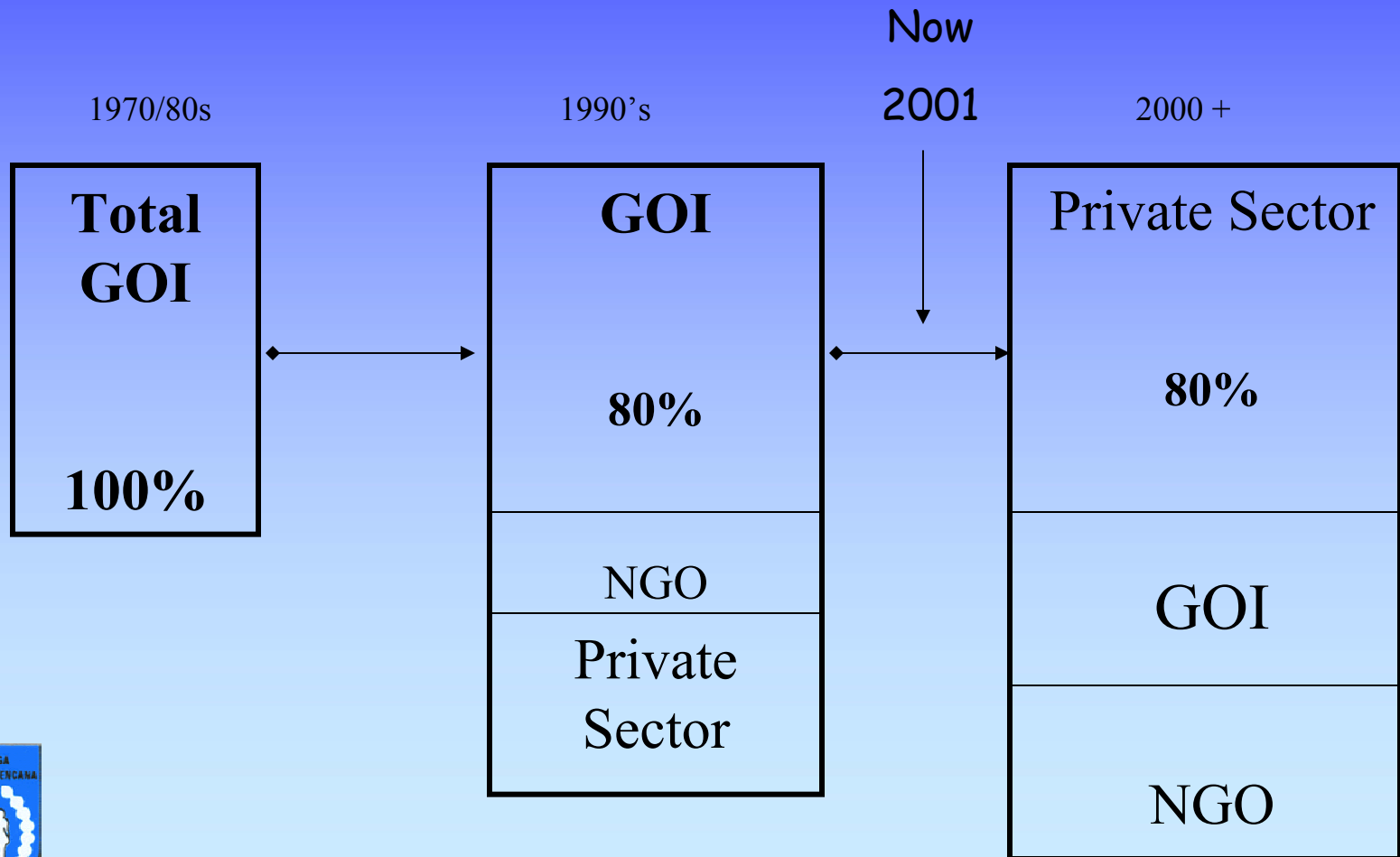


# Goal of Contraception Logistic System

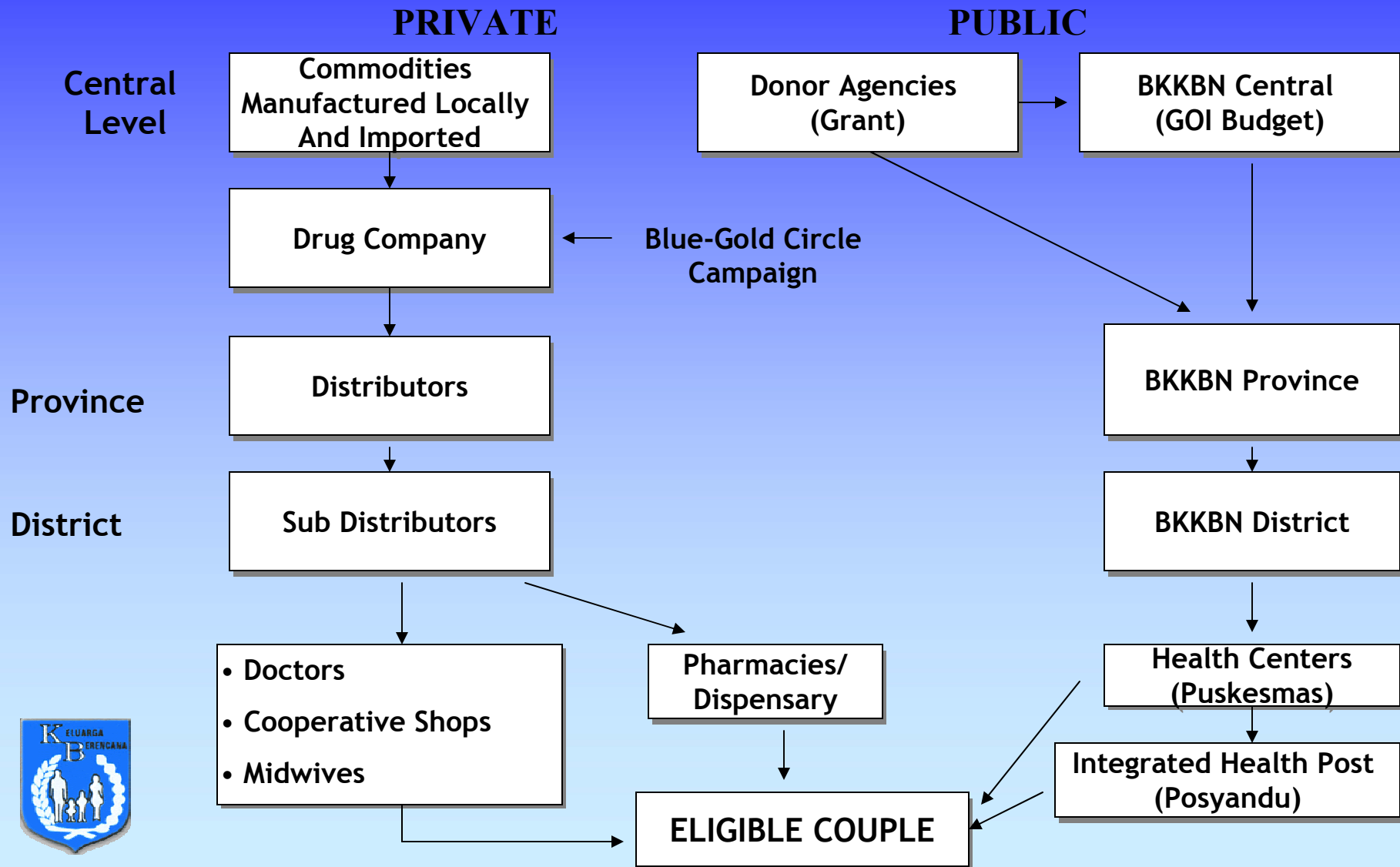

# CONTRACEPTIVE COMMODITY DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

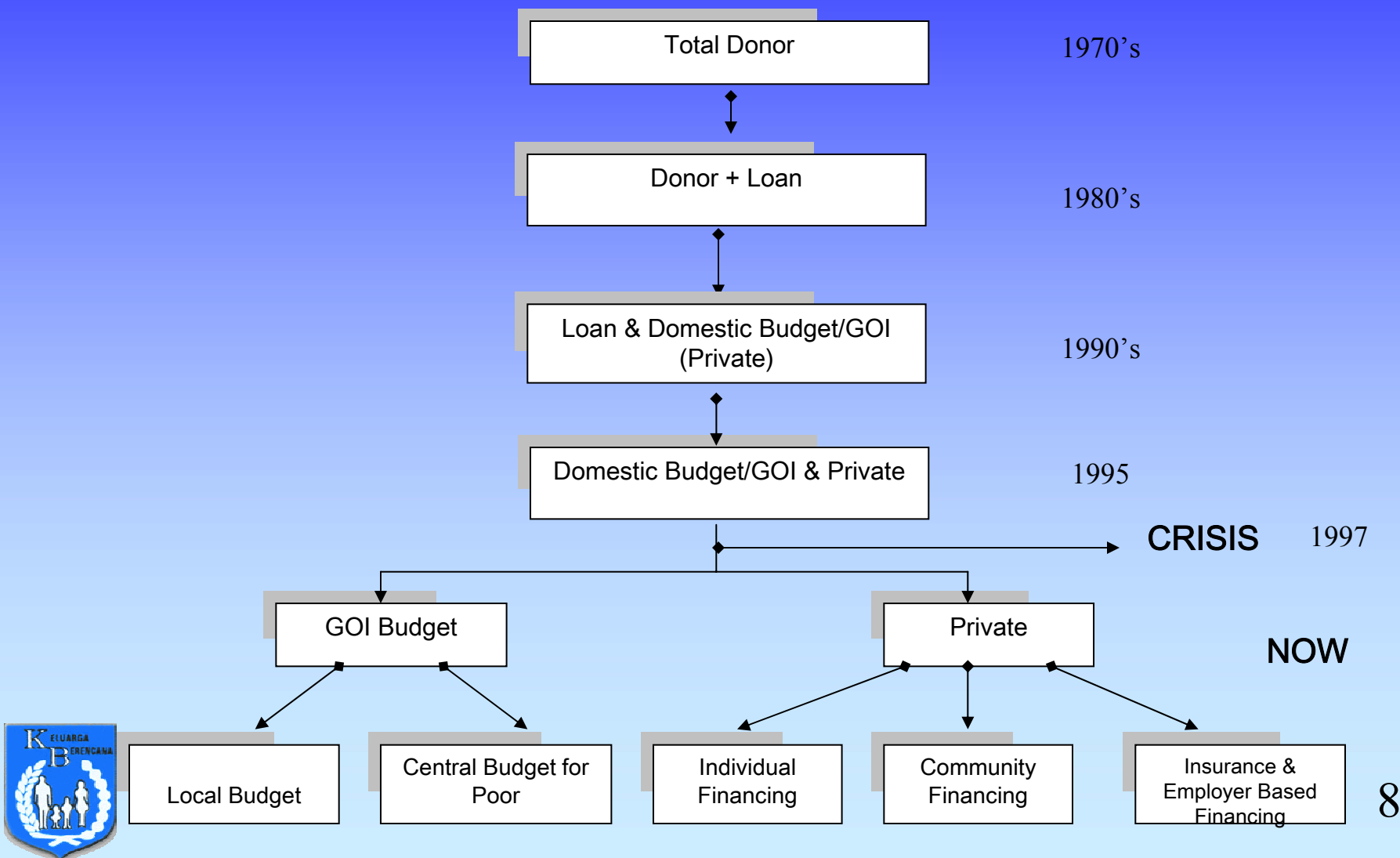

2. Injectable	2001	9 million doses
3. Implant	2001	329,000 units
4. IUD	1999/00	300,000 units
