


Investing in Young People

World Population is estimated to be 7.023 billion. PPD calls upon South-South Cooperation for the 59% of 7.023 billion population. The alliance of 26 developing countries under the umbrella of PPD, the adjuration is, the youth and adolescent population of the Global South will proffer better world if their requirement would be addressed with due accord.

Key Points:

- 1.8 billion population of the world are in 10-24 age group, they are constituting 28% of the world population. Another 15% are in the below 10 years age group. That is, total 43% of the world population are in under 25 years age group. Their future and fate is depending on the decision and investment taken by the another 67% of the adult population.
- Every year, 16 million adolescent girls give birth and about 70,000 adolescents die due to the causes related to pregnancy and childbirth in the developing countries, another 3.2 million undergo unsafe abortions.



In his statement, Dr. Harsh Vardhan , Honourable Minister of Health and Family Welfare and Chair, Partners in Population and Development said that



‘Twenty six member countries of PPD is the home of nearly 62% of the young population globally. In PPD member countries, the large proportion of youth and adolescent in the population structure offer a unique window for development and we must take proactive stage to optimize gains from this demographic dividend. To do this , we have to create, invest in and capitalize on this opportunity by adopting specific policies , programs and creating favorable environment for young and working age population. I am urging the Government to adopt right based and gender- responsive approaches to maximize opportunities for gainful employment, especially for women, strengthen migration policies which ensure accesses to the health and welfare services to the migrant population, specially to ensure SRHR and protection of the rights to the young migrant population.’
