














In 2006 the WHO identified 57 countries with a health workforce crisis.

but only **4%** of the world's health workers.


Flo, the beleaguered health worker

Too few **Poorly** supported Inadequately educated


Inequitably distributed



More health workers, better health outcomes




Rural populations have less access to health workers




...which affects health outcomes


Greater opportunities to invest in human capital (health, education)
