Kenya has been an active participant in EARHN and has actively participated in the development and implementation of the EARHN strategic Plan 2017-2021.

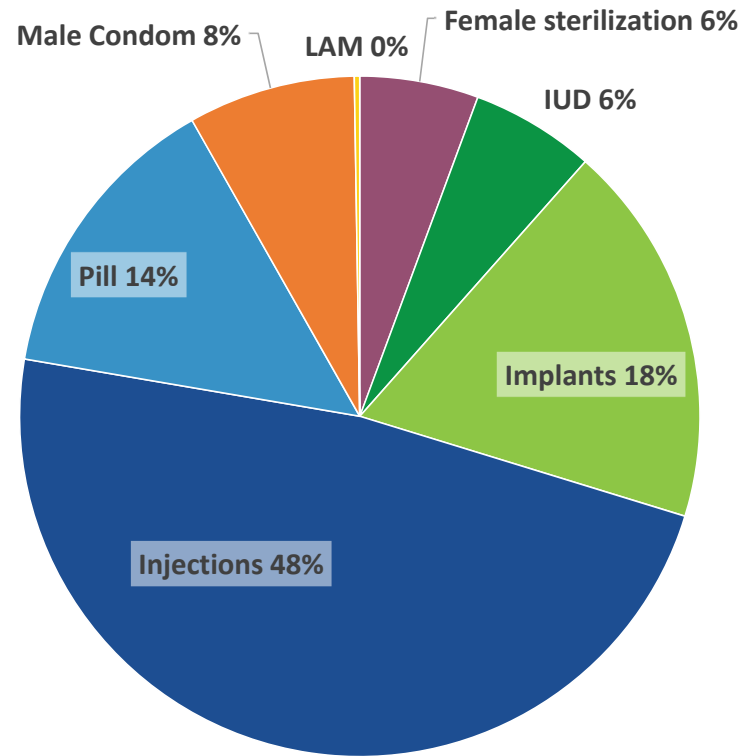
Family planning priority Areas for Family planning advocacy

 - Addressing myths and misconception

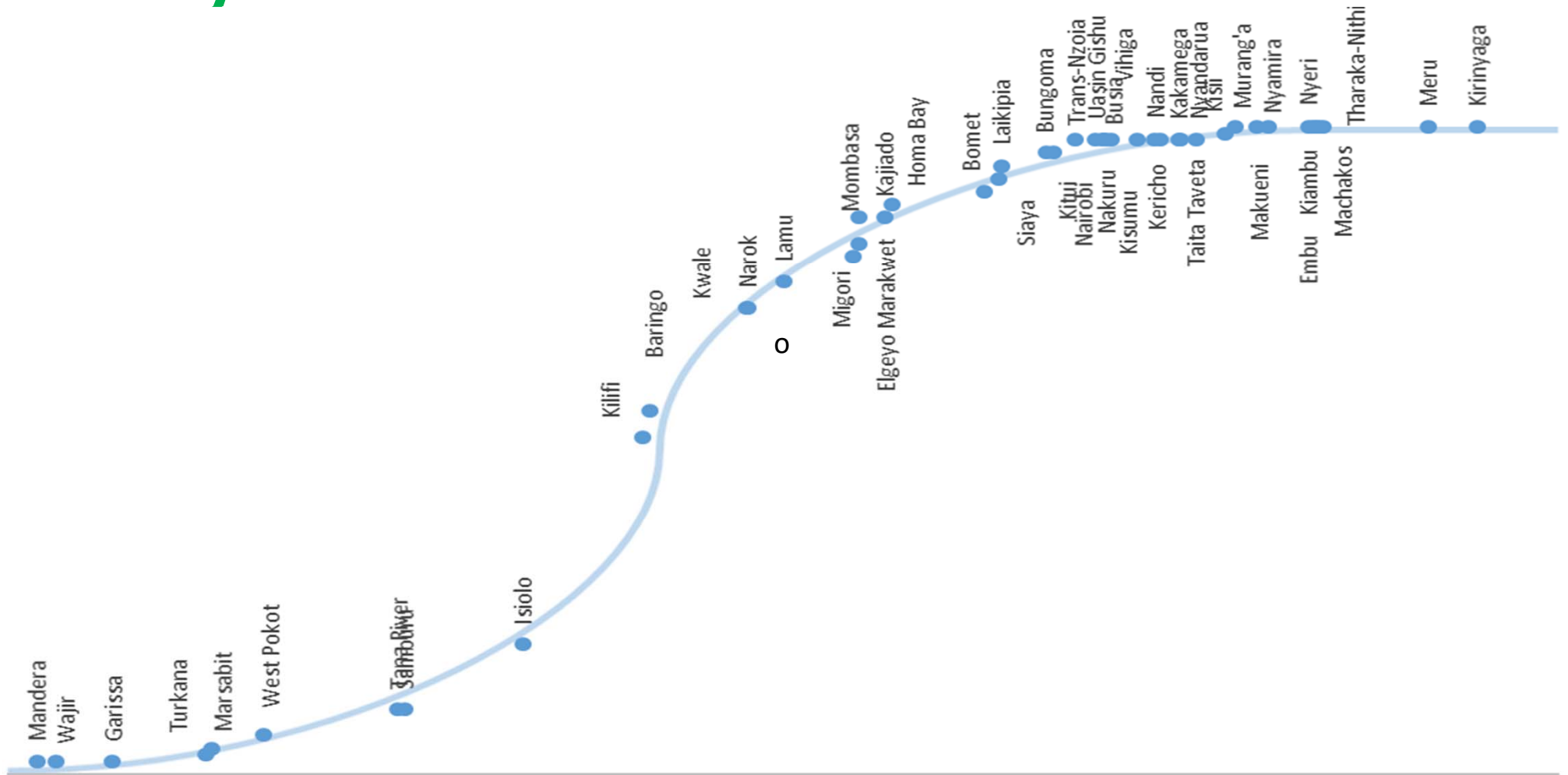
Selected Population and RH indicators

Under Strategic Focus 1: Advocacy and Strategic Partnerships

1. Finalize and validate Advocacy strategy by December 2019
2. Advocate for increased resources for FP and improved collaboration between NCPD, MoH and partners
3. Finalize the harmonized Resource Mobilization Strategy for all stakeholders
4. Community distribution for family planning by CHVs

Under Strategic Focus 2: Coordination and South-South Learning

1. Validate and disseminate the National Guidelines on FP-CIP
2. Advocate for counties that have not developed their FP-CIPs to do so
3. Improve Partner mapping and synergies to support documentation, sharing and dissemination of good RH/FP policies and practices across the region
4. Develop M&E Framework for DD and disseminate the DD Roadmap
