**Subject: Request of Nomination for the scholarship of One Year "Post Graduate Diploma (PGD) in Population and Policy Analysis (PPA)" provided by the Government of South Africa**

We are pleased to inform that, PPD, with the support of the Department of Social Development of the Government of South Africa, is offering ten (10) scholarships of a "Post Graduate Diploma (PGD) in Population and Policy Analysis (PPA)" for the professionals working in the field of Population and Development in PPD member countries' to improve evidence based policies and programmes for sustainable human development.

The course will be conducted at the Northwest University, Matfiken Campus, South Africa; for the duration of One (1) year full time study bearing 120 credit units, commencing in early 2021. The aim of the course is to provide advanced understanding and practical skills for interlinking research, policy and programmes for middle and high-level managers with planning responsibilities.

The scholarship will cover registration fees, tuition fees, and accommodation on campus; a contribution of ZAR 24,000 towards meals expenses and a contribution of ZAR 8000 for textbooks, printing and stationery. Successful applicant should secure their own funding/ sponsorship for travel and other expense including South African Qualification Authority (SAQA), study permits/visas and medical insurance.

Scholarship awards will be considered on the basis of academic record and relevance of the course to the applicant's job and field work.

In order to be eligible for scholarship, the candidate must be

1. Holding a graduate/bachelor degree preferably in Social Science

2. Government service holder with at least 2 years' experience in population & development.

3. Have good communication and understanding skills in English language since English is the medium of the instruction of the course.

Considering that, you are kindly requested to send us the nomination along with duly filled application form, CV, Passport size photo and the necessary academic and job certificate of candidate including a letter of approval from the employer before 17 April 2020.
