- ✓ Regional review to Cairo
- ✓ Complementary to Agenda 2030
- ✓ Advanced for its human rights' approach
- ✓ Focused on inequalities

## Mexico's position at Nairobi Summit ICPD+25:

- ✓ Cairo + Agenda 2030 + Montevideo Consensus
- ✓ Mexico regional leader: wide and plural delegation
- ✓ Voice to civil society and academia



# Mexico's Commitments ICPD+25

1. Reduce maternal deaths, particularly those caused by unsafe abortions by warranting access to comprehensive health attention + emergency contraception methods + legal interruption of pregnancy (ILE)

2. Consolidation of the National Strategy to Prevent Teen Pregnancy (ENAPEA) focusing on sexual violence against girls, which is critical.


3. Strengthen health services towards universalization, based on a human rights approach

# Mexico's Commitments ICPD+25/ Main challenges

4. Address the backlash narratives that undermine women's rights and that promote multiple forms of discrimination

5. Address the obstacles that hinder women's rights to a life free of violence, implementing actions that prevent and identify sexual violence against girls and teenagers; as well as mechanisms to eliminate femicide violence.

6. Comprehensive sexual education (CSE) at all levels, starting in primary school, in order to foster gradual information based on scientific facts needed for psycho-emotional skills' development to live a healthy life.





