






TRENDS IN PERCENTAGE OF KENYA'S POPULATION IN SELECTED AGE GROUPS (1969-2019)







KENYA'S POPULATION PYRAMID (2009 and 2019)

Kenya Population Pyramid - 2009 Census




















TRENDS IN SELECTED DEMOGRAPHIC AND HEALTH INDICATORS 2003-2022









- Counties with poor education outcomes and high prevalence of FGM have the highest prevalence of teenage pregnancy

- **Commit'13-15**: eiminating Gender Based Violence and Harmful Practices
- **Commit'16:** In the spirit of leaving no one behind, commits to provision of Reproductive Health Services and information in Humanitarian and Fragile Contexts
- **Commit'17:** To ensure Kenya accelerates the promise of ICPD Programme of Action the country commits to track and monitor the implementation of iCPD Nairobi commitments

Kenya's Commitment to Deliver UHC


- Pilot of UHC in 2018 in 4 counties and roll out to remaining 43 counties in 2022
 - Abolish all user fees at primary level and the secondary level
 - Free Maternity Programme ("Linda Mama")



- More than 13,000 health workers trained on Emergency Obstetric and Neonatal Care (EmONC)
- Trained 175 EmONC mentors, additional 130 midwives,






- Reforms at NHIF to cover NCDs and mental health

- Intergovernmental Participation Agreement (IPA) Framework –governors sign agreement with CS for Health to invest resources in UHC
- Private-Public Partnership (PPP) for PHC in to unlock new finances for the health sector from private sector
