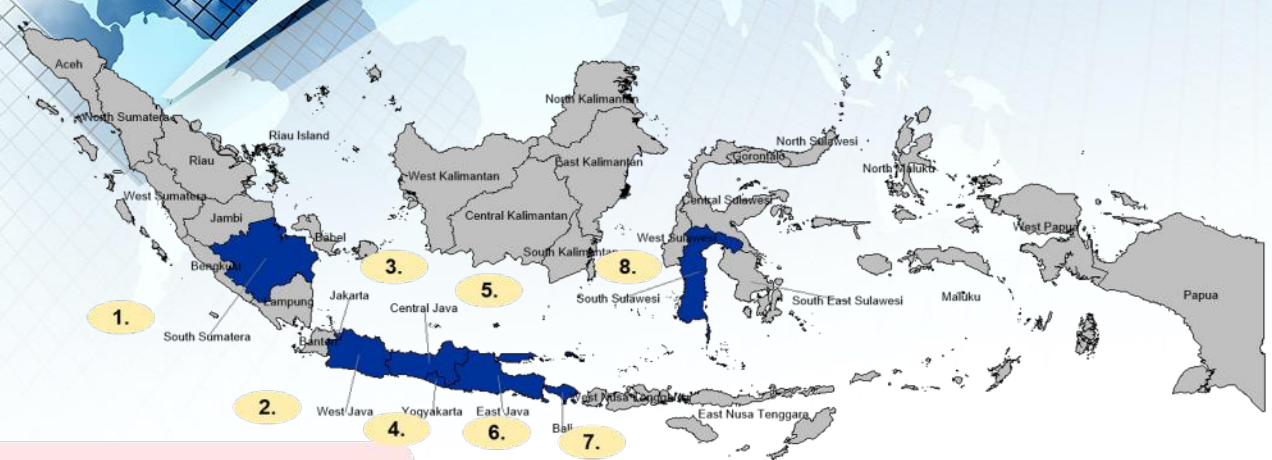

Knowledge Sharing Under SSTC Year 2021-2022

- Hosted the international webinar which showcase eleven best practices of PPD Countries in implementing reproductive health, family planning, and population program, including innovation and program implementation in pandemic situation.
- Webinar was held by BKKBN together with the ONFP Tunisia to commemorate the International Women's day to share best practices in population issues, especially related to the important role of government to invest in women and girls.
- In 2022 BKKBN have implemented five trainings:
 1. Supply chain management for the Philippines (virtually)
 2. Muslim Religious Leaders in Family Planning for Asia and African Countries (virtually)
 3. Bridging leadership in family planning (virtually).
 4. Training for 40 delegates came from Afghanistan to Indonesia to learn on maternal, child health, and family planning program implementation in Indonesia.
 5. Training for Bangsamoro Filipinne Mindanao.
