There are no South-South Resources acquired for only that modality.

Where can you get South-South Cooperation Resources?

Where you get other resources - Almost every resource can be repurposed for SSC

Therefore general resource constraints are also SSC constraints

The difference is that generally resources are earmarked to help others, for solidarity, for mutual gains.

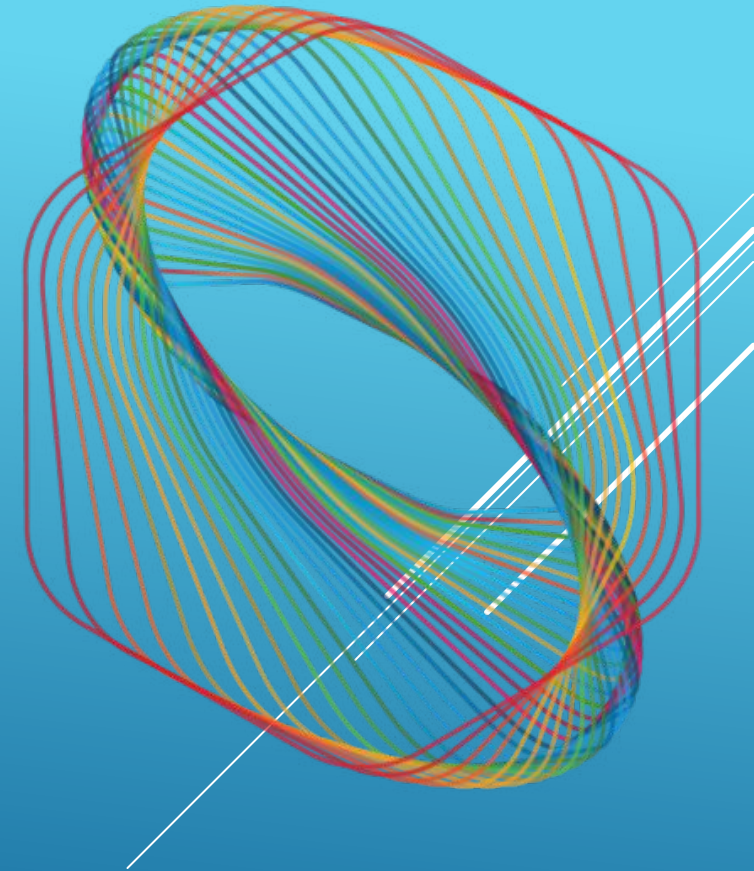

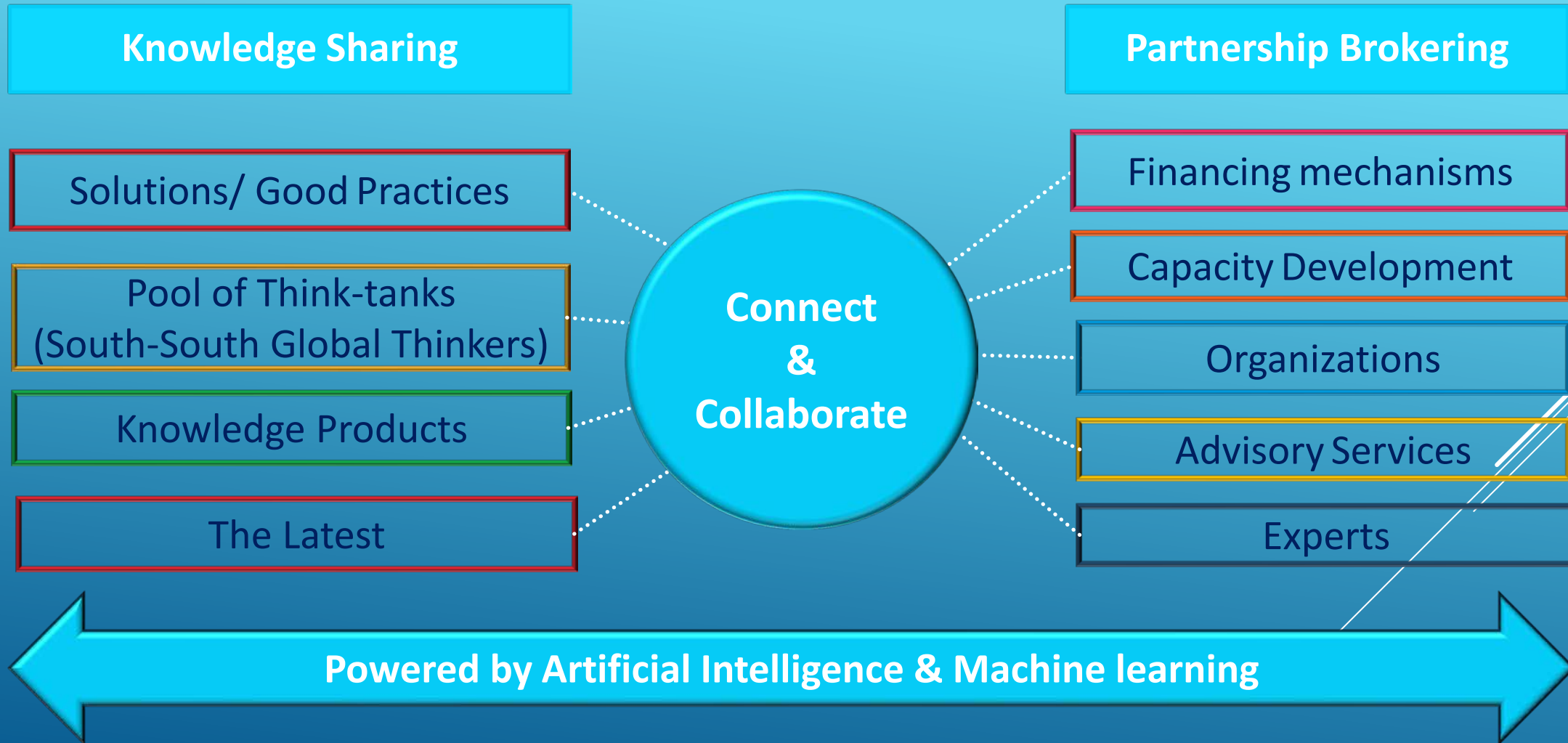
