# THERE ARE NO "SOUTH-SOUTH RESOURCES EXCEPT BY DESIGNATION"

There are no South-South Resources acquired for only that modality.

<u>Where can you get South-</u> <u>South Cooperation</u> <u>Resources?</u> Where you get other resources - Almost every resource can be repurposed for SSC <u>Therefore general resource</u> <u>constraints</u> are also SSC <u>constraints</u>

<u>The difference is that generally</u> <u>resources are earmarked to help</u> <u>others, for solidarity, for mutual</u> <u>gains.</u>




UNOSSC, in consultation with over 15 UN Agencies, developed a global platform for sharing knowledge and brokering partnerships to:
