PPD representation at the 21st Session of the High-Level Committee on South-South Cooperation, NYC, USA and mission to ZIMBABWE and SOUTH AFRICA for Bi-lateral Engagements, 25 May- 18 June'2023

The Officer in Charge met with the UNFPA officials for assistance with the registration to attend the High-level Committee on South-South Cooperation (SSC), NYC, USA, scheduled for 30 May – 2 June 2023.

The OiC delivered his remarks in the general debate and review of progress made in implementing the Buenos Aires Plan of Action for Promoting and Implementing Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries, the new directions strategy for SSC, the Nairobi outcome document of the High-level United Nations Conference on SSC and the Buenos Aires outcome document of the second High-level United Nations Conference on SSC.





Implementation of Reverse Linkage Project for programmatic and policy changes in Uganda and Zimbabwe using the best practice of Ghana.





Zimbabwe National Family Planning Council (ZNFPC) conducted a youth-friendly services outreach program under the Partners in Population and Development (PPD) project fund on adolescent sexual and reproductive health (ASRH) youth-friendly service provision. The project is focusing on the provision of youth friendly health services through (FP services, MHM, HTS, STI Management, and Reproductive Health Education to youth as well Information dissemination) outreaches and community mobilisers in Hopley, Harare. The outreach programs were conducted during the month of July 2023 to address the needs of adolescents and young people and to give them comprehensive information about reproductive health issues.





Clinical services including HTS, STI management and treatment as well as family planning services were offered during the period under review. Comprehensive Sexuality Education sessions were conducted with both in school and out of school youth aged 10-24 years during the period.

PPD Scholarship program funded by South Africa Government

The Government of South Africa has provided one-year scholarships for a Post-Graduate Diploma (PGD) in Population and Policy Analysis at Northwest University for young professionals from PPD member countries. Thirteen scholars from Gambia, Mali, Pakistan, Ethiopia, Uganda, Egypt, Ghana, and Bangladesh got the scholarship from Northwest University. The applicants are currently proceeding through the SAQA application. The Government of South Africa and PPD are facilitating the program.

Training & Meeting on "Institutional Delivery and Uses of Tab Misoprostol to Prevent PPH at Satellite Level to Reduce Maternal Mortality", 17-25 June 2023 at Bangladesh.



Partners in Population and Development along with the Director General of Family Planning organized 12 Training and Meeting at Manikgani and Gazipur, Bangladesh. This training and meeting were held under the project SSCAF with financial support from the China Government. The focus is on institutional delivery and the use of Tab Misoprostol to prevent postpartum hemorrhage (PPH) at the satellite level, with the ultimate goal of reducing maternal mortality.
